1. $5625=9$

$$625=7$$

$$25=?$$

Answer= $5625/25=225=2+2+5=9$

$$625/25=25=2+5=7$$

$$25/25=1$$

Not an odd number

Higher than 90

What number am I?

Answer: 100

Answer: take first digit of first number and take the second number => together you have the result

$$67 + 9 \text{ is then } 69$$

Answer: 936

$$2\ 35 \Rightarrow 2*2\ 3+5 \Rightarrow 48$$

$$78\ 1 \Rightarrow 7+8\ 1*1 \Rightarrow 151$$
